1. The Complete Life Course. (\$5) A training course designed for use with faith communities but appropriate for other groups, including caregivers, parish nurses, outreach volunteers, service providers, and nursing home staff. The curriculum covers practical, physical, spiritual, and cultural aspects of care for the dying and the bereaved. Included are 17 one-hour modules, each with lecture materials, experiential exercises, and PowerPoint slides. Fee covers postage.

1. Speakers Bureau Kit. (\$200) To get your speakers bureau started, you can use these PowerPoint slides, speaker's notes, and overheads for four presentations:

- Death is a Natural Part of the Life Cycle - An overview of our cultural conditioning.
- Choices at the End of Life - Advance Directives, Care Options and more.
- Zero Acceptance of Pain (ZAP) - Good pain management is possible.
- The Journey at the End of Life - Physical, emotional, social, and spiritual changes and challenges.

2. Trigger Video. (\$20) An 8.5-minute video created in Hawaii to be shown before speakers' presentations. The video is designed to draw people in and emotionally prepare them for beginning discussions on end-of-life issues. The personal stories of three people and their families bring to life the topics of advance directives, end-of-life conversations, and pain management.

3. Public Service Announcement (PSA) (\$20) - A 30-second television PSA features Frances Kakugawa speaking about the end-of-life plans her mother Matsue made before she was stricken with Alzheimer's disease. The video and PSA reflect Hawaii's multi-cultural society.
